Florida Law & Rules

4 PDH (Approved Courses with FBPE Provider)

This topic is required before license renewal deadline in February 2011, and this course fulfills that requirement through fast moving presentations by legal and engineering experts that are knowledgeable on the Engineering Registration Law and the Rules of the Board of Professional Engineers and its practical applications. The class covers common problem areas in the law relating to the use of the seal certification by an engineer, adoption of the work of another engineer, the responsibilities of the engineer of record, the role of the prime professional and the delegated engineer and how misunderstandings may lead to charges of misconduct or negligence. The class will be presented by:

- Ed Bayo, Esquire**, former Assistant Attorney General and Legal Counsel to the Board of Professional Engineers. Ed's current practice at Metzger, Grossman, Furlow and Bayo includes the representation of professional licensees, regulated entities and interested parties before regulatory agencies, Florida Courts and the Division of Administrative Hearings. Topics covered will include the legal aspects of Chapter 471, F.S. and Chapter 61G-15 the Rules of the Board of Professional Engineers.

- Myron Hayden, Ph.D., P.E.**, Principal and Consulting Geotechnical Engineer with Environmental and Geotechnical Specialists, Inc. (EGS) will utilize his 30 plus years of practical experience in "everyday" engineering and cover engineer responsibilities and plan requirements.

This course will introduce the seven key concepts of Green Building and Sustainable Development and will be focusing on case studies of sustainable developments and local, regional and national certification programs. These concepts will assist attendees of the conference in defining goals and establishing an action plan for projects. CONTINUING EDUCATION

Florida is unique in that it requires four of the eight hour biennial hours to be on the Florida Registration Law and the Rules of the Board of Professional Engineers. The Law and Rules course must also be approved by the Florida Board. The other four hours must be in "area of practice". This does not mean licensees must take CE in the discipline in which they were originally tested but in a discipline that is recognized by testing. Engineers are licensed as Professional Engineers and may practice in any discipline in which he or she is competent by virtue of education, experience or testing.
